

# We grow through discipleship

- Discipleship as ‘a long obedience in the same direction’ [Eugene Peterson].
- ‘You did not chose me; I chose you.’
- Making disciples - the main task of the Church today – for the whole of life – home, leisure and work matter.
- We grow as disciples as we engage in mission [Mt 28:16].
- The purpose of being a disciple is to be a blessing to others and to bear fruit.
- If we’re going to preach good news, we’ve got to be good news first – individually and as a community.

through worship, prayer and study




# And look outwards: Develop spiritual curiosity
